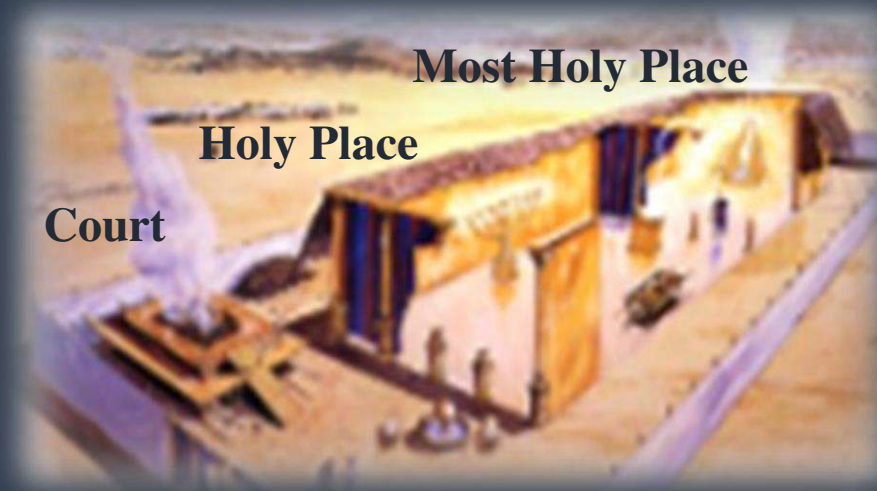


3. John Saw Christ in Vision in the Holy Place

“And in the midst of the seven candlesticks one like unto the Son of man, clothed with a garment down to the foot, and girt about the paps with a golden girdle.” Revelation 1:13.



The apostle John, while in exile on the island of Patmos around 91 AD, saw Christ in the Holy Place of the heavenly sanctuary where He ascended after His ascension in 31 AD, some forty days after His resurrection and ten days before Pentecost. (Acts 1:3).

The Candlestick represents the Holy Spirit; the Table of Shewbread points to the Word of God - the Old Testament already written and the New Testament which Christ gave us after His ascension. The Altar of Incense identifies His work of perpetual intercession on man's behalf. Therefore, this is one strong evidence among others that Christ did not entered into the Most Holy Place in 31 AD: He entered the Holy Place.

4. "I shall not die but live and declare His Works"

"The mass of people think that if a person is prepared to die, he is prepared for the coming of the Lord. But they do not consider the difference between dying and standing alive to meet the Lord at His appearing.



It is one thing to die in the Lord, to yield our spirits to Him while He is pleading for us before the Father's throne, and quite a different thing to stand in the time of trouble after Jesus has ceased to plead in man's behalf, after His priesthood is closed, and He is preparing to come to redeem His own, and take vengeance of His foes.

They who realize these things will bless heaven that means [Most Holy Place] have been devised in the mercy of God for the perfection of the saints." *Life Sketches of James and Ellen White*, p. 431.

5. Perfection of the Saints: Work in the Most Holy Place

“And I will put enmity between thee and the woman, and between thy seed and her seed; it shall bruise thy head, and thou shalt bruise his heel.” Genesis 3:15

6. Sealing or Perfecting of the Saints in Revelation

The Perfection of the saints or Sealing [in the mind] is the work of Christ in the Most Holy Place which He started since 1844 for the dead and is soon to pass to the Living under the Sunday Law—as prophesied in Daniel 12 and Revelation 13.



“This is the test that the people of God must have before they are sealed. All who prove their loyalty to God by observing his law, and refusing to accept a spurious Sabbath, will rank under the banner of the Lord God Jehovah, and will receive the seal of the living God. Those who yield the truth of heavenly origin, and accept the Sunday Sabbath, will receive the mark of the beast.” 15 Manuscript Release, 15.3

7. The Completed Work in the Sanctuary

“The complete fulfillment of the covenant as promised in Daniel 8:14; 9:24-27 “Then shall the sanctuary be cleansed” with its objectives stated “to finish the transgression, and to make an end of sins, and to make reconciliation for iniquity, and to bring in everlasting righteousness, and to seal up the vision and prophecy, and to anoint the most Holy, is fulfilled within the process of the Investigative Judgment.



By the time the Investigative Judgment in heaven is finished, there is a close of human probation and the problem of sin in the mind and hearts of God’s people will be solved. “Moral perfection” for the living must be attained before probation closes.” Final Deliverance in the Covenants of God, 122.7

8. Christ – the 144000 – Fit Man of Leviticus 16:21

The experience of the 144000 will parallel the experience of Christ in His humanity after the work of the Most Holy Place (Final Atonement) is accomplished in them:

- 1. Both have the fallen nature of sinful humanity - affected by sin**
2. Both have no stains or scars of sin upon the mind - not infected by sin anymore - Satan's character has been removed – his Perversion Character
- 3. Both stand before God without a mediator – Most Holy Place closed**
4. Both have received the Spirit without measure - John 3: 34
- 5. Both have perfection of the mind without perfection of the flesh - perfection of the flesh - immortality - is obtained at the Second Coming**
6. Both have demonstrated that fallen humanity can keep the law of God perfectly through the power of the Holy Spirit

9. Consistent Pattern of Revelation: 8 Visions

- ◆ **A knowledge of the structure of Revelation is vital to an understanding of the timing for the final endtime fulfillment of seals, trumpets, thunders, plagues and other chronological events based on the 8 Heavenly Visions.**
- ◆ Not only it is necessary to recognize the two major lines of prophecy in Revelation that are written in sequence and continuity, but it is important to know the arrangement of the book according to the eight visions and heavenly scenes. The eight visions provide the framework that is vital to an understanding of an endtime fulfillment of seals, trumpets, woes, thunders, preparation of God's Army to face Lucifer and his foes in the last scenes of the Great Controversy against the Creator's Law which began in the Most Holy Place in the heavenly Sanctuary. Isaiah 14:4-23; Ezekiel 28:11-19.
- ◆ **There is a consistent pattern in the book of Revelation. There are 8 major Visions, each beginning with a Scene in heaven, after which an historical Outline is presented. There is an Interlude in each outline, after which an eschatological Culmination or Events to the Second Coming of Messiah and all connected to the number '7' - perfection, completeness, whole, mystery of Godliness finished.**
- ◆ The 4 first Visions are found in the first major Line of Prophecy consisting of Chapters 1-11 and the last 4 visions are found in the last major Line of Prophecy consisting of Chapters 12-22. The structure reveals an endtime application of Seals, Trumpets, Thunders and Plagues. It gives correct sequence and continuity to the entire picture of the history of God's Church from the Kingdom of Grace to the Kingdom of Glory, from the Judgment of the Dead to the Judgment of the Living, from the First to the Second Coming.

10. First 4 Heavenly Visions: 31 AD - 1844 - Today

“All that God has in prophetic history specified to be fulfilled in the past, has been, and all that is yet to come in its order will be.” MS 32, 1896

- ◆ In the first heavenly vision, John saw 7 golden candlesticks (about 91 AD). Revelation 1:12. The lamp with the 7 candlesticks is in the Holy Place of the Heavenly Sanctuary and points to the fact that Christ was ministering in that compartment since 31 AD. John saw his first vision which begins the 7 Letters to the Churches - Historical Application - Future Application of the Churches - Most Holy Place (1844 - today)
- ◆ The second heavenly scene parallels Daniel 7:10 -13 which points to the Investigative Judgment in the Most Holy Place on October 22, 1844. The 7 Seals point historically to the Judgment of the Dead but applies in reality to the Judgment of the Living soon to begin — Revelation 4 -7
- ◆ The third heavenly scene reveals that prayers are still offered in the sanctuary above when the censer is cast on the earth - the Trumpets are not the final plagues - they are judgments mingled with mercy while probation is still opened. Isaiah 26:9 - Revelation 8:2 – 6
- ◆ The fourth heavenly scene is the measuring of the temple and the MHP is seen with the ark. Christ has His bride ready to vindicate Him - the 144000, the fit man of Leviticus 16:21 - The 7 thunders are a delineation of events under Revelation 18:1-4 and are not the close of probation - Revelation 10:1-11; 11:15-17, 19 - see Song of Songs

11. Last 4 Heavenly Visions - Chapters 12-22 - Conflicts

“All that God has in prophetic history specified to be fulfilled in the past, has been, and all that is yet to come in its order will be.” MS 32, 1896

◆ The fifth heavenly scene is Revelation 12-13 which is the vision of the church who upholds the true 7th day Sabbath - Revelation 12:1 and stands against the foe of Christ and His church.

The dragon which has been cast out on the earth attacks the woman twice - for 1260 years and the second time following the timelines of Daniel 12 - 1260, 1290, 1335 literal days under the National Sunday Law and Universal Sunday Law followed by the Universal Death Decree.

◆ The sixth heavenly scene is Revelation 15 - 18 – song - repeat of 3 Angels Message - plagues and close of probation

◆ The seventh heavenly scene is Revelation 19 - King is coming

◆ The eighth heavenly scene is Revelation 21, 22 - New Earth – Third Coming
