1. First plague/vial

"And there fell a noisome and grievous sore upon the men which had the mark of the beast, and upon them which worshipped his image" Revelation 16:2

2. Second plague/vial

"Upon the sea and it became as the blood of a dead man: and every living soul died in the sea." Revelation 16:3 - (2/3).

3. Third plague/vial

"Upon the rivers and fountains of waters; and they became blood." Revelation 16:4 -7 - (2/3).

1. First plague/vial — Noisome and Grievous Sore

Noisome - disgusting, offensive, or harmful, often in its smell. Noisome does not come from "noise," but from the Middle English word noysome, which has the same meaning as noisome. **Grievous** - serious, severe, grave, bad, critical, dreadful, terrible, awful, crushing, calamitous. Webster Dictionary, 1828

4. Fourth plague/vial

"Upon the sun; and power was given unto him to scorch men with fire. And men were scorched with great heat, and blasphemed the name of God." Revelation 16: 8, 9

5. Fifth plague/vial

"Upon the seat of the beast; and his kingdom was full of darkness; and they gnawed their tongues for pain, and blasphemed the God of heaven."
Revelation 16: 10, 11

6. Sixth plague/vial

"Upon the great river Euphrates; and the water thereof was dried up, that the way of the kings of the east might be prepared." Revelation 16:12-16

7. Seventh plague/vial

"Into the air; and there came a great voice out of the temple of heaven, from the throne, saying, It is done. – islands fled away – mountains not found – great hail – judgment on Babylon the Great Whore."

4. Fourth plague/vial

5. Fifth plague/vial

6. Sixth plague/vial –

7. Seventh plague/vial
