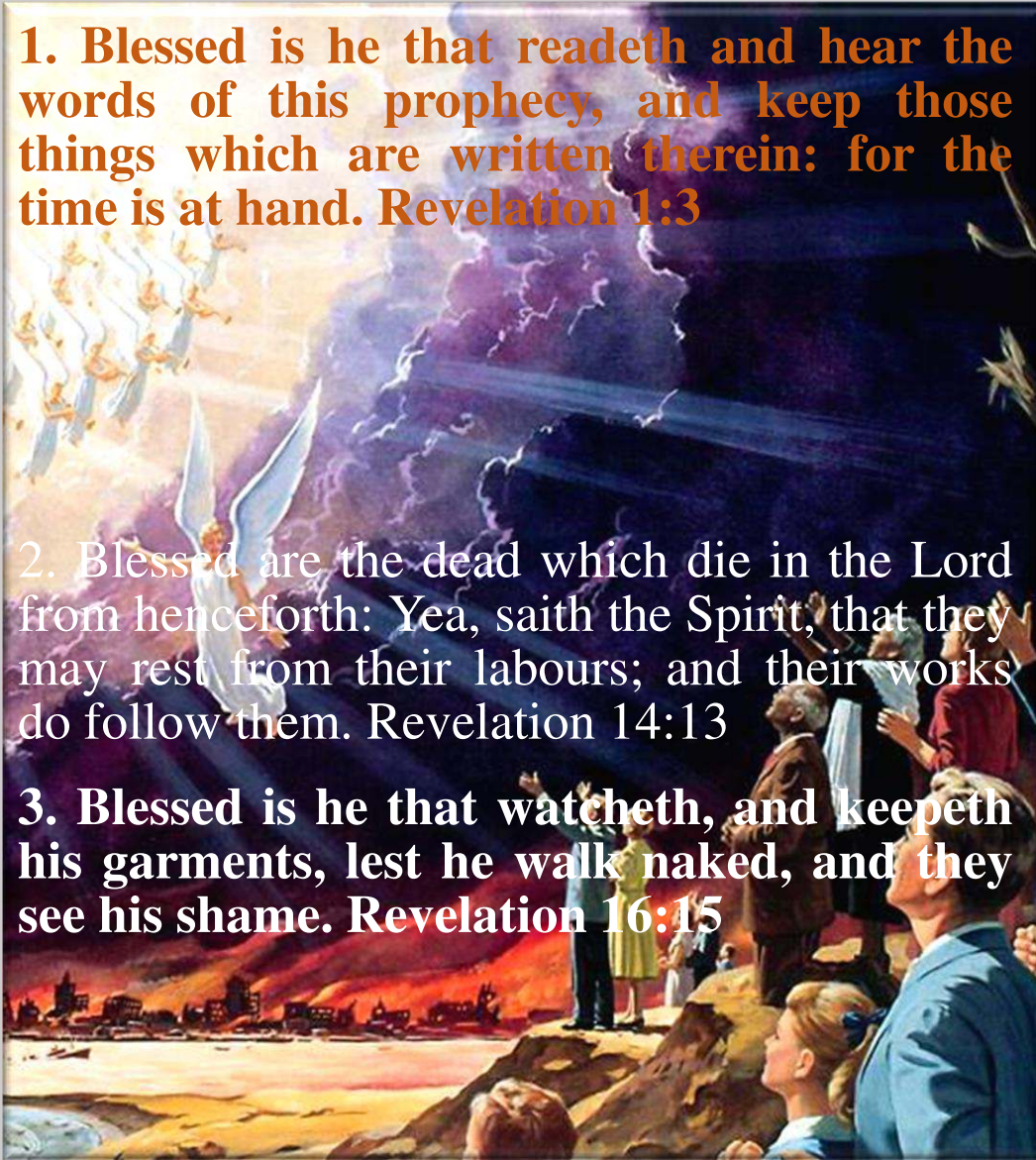


19. 7 Blessings - White Raiment – Blessings 1 - 3

1. Revelation 1:3

The time is at hand – Matthew 24:33-37

“When ye shall see all these things, know that it is near, even at the doors. Verily I say unto you, This generation shall not pass, till all these things be fulfilled. Heaven and earth shall pass away, but my words shall not pass away. But of that day and hour knoweth no man, no, not the angels of heaven, but my Father only. But as the days of Noe were, so shall also the coming of the Son of man be.”

2. Revelation 14:13

“For I know that my redeemer liveth, and that he shall stand at the latter day upon the earth.’ Job 19:25

3. Revelation 16:15

“And they were both naked, the man and his wife, and were not ashamed.” Genesis 2:25.

“The coming of Christ as our high priest to the most holy place [1844], for the cleansing of the sanctuary, brought to view in Daniel 8:14; the coming of the Son of man to the Ancient of days, as presented in Daniel 7:13; and the coming of the Lord to his temple, foretold by Malachi, are descriptions of the same event; and this is also represented by the coming of the bridegroom to the marriage, described by Christ in the parable of the ten virgins, of Matthew 25. The Great Controversy, chapter 24, 426.

5. Revelation 20:6

“The resurrection of Jesus was a type of the final resurrection of all who sleep in Him.... The same form will come forth, but it will be free from disease and every defect. It lives again, bearing the same individuality of features, so that friend will recognize friend.” Last Day Events, 291

6. Revelation 22:7

7. Revelation 22:14
