# The Biblical Calendar **Crucifixion Timeline**

Every fact connected with the crucifixion of Christ may be verified without a doubt to demonstrate the validity of the Luni-Solar **Barley** Harvest Calendation.

#### The Biblical Calendar Agricultural Season in Exodus 9

#### **Biblical Agricultural Season:**

"And the flax [seed] and the barley [grain] was smitten: for the **barley** [firstfruits] was in the ear, and the flax was bolled. But the wheat [grain] and the rie [grain] were not smitten: for they were not grown up." Exodus 9:31, 32.

#### The Biblical Calendar Agricultural Season in Exodus 9

**Agricultural Season**: Spring At the time of the 7<sup>th</sup> plague, the flax and the **barley** were smitten because both were grown up. **Barley** is **ready** in Egypt and Palestine, in the **Spring**.

## The Biblical Calendar Month of the Year in Exodus 12

## **Biblical Month of the Year:** First Month "This month shall be unto you the beginning of months: it shall be the first month of the year to you."

*Exodus 12:2.* 

## The Biblical Calendar Spring Appointed Times: Leviticus 23 Biblical Appointed Times:

 "In the fourteenth day of the first month at even is the LORD's Passover."
Leviticus 23:5, (emphasis supplied).

2. "And on the fifteenth day of the same month is the feast of Unleavened Bread unto the LORD... In the first day ye shall have an holy convocation [15<sup>th</sup>]... in the seventh day is an holy convocation [21<sup>st</sup>]..." Leviticus 23:6.

## The Biblical Calendar Spring Appointed Times: Leviticus 23 Biblical Appointed Times:

**3.** "...Then ye shall bring a sheaf of the **firstfruits** of your harvest unto the priest: and he shall wave the **sheaf**...on the morrow after the sabbath [Abib 16]..." Leviticus 23:10,11.

(emphasis supplied). – That Sheaf was **Barley**.

**4.** "Even unto the morrow after the seventh sabbath shall ye number fifty days..." *Leviticus 23:16.* [**Pentecost** – 9<sup>th</sup> of the 3<sup>rd</sup> Month]

## The Biblical Calendar **First Month of the Year in Exodus 12** First Month of the Year: Abib The time of the 10<sup>th</sup> plague of Egypt was in the spring corresponding to March – April (Julian-Gregorian Reckoning). The religious year started around that time.

#### **First Month:**

Abib means: Barley is Ripe

## The Biblical Calendar Spring Appointed Times: Leviticus 23 Appointed Times:

The appointed times were holy convocations unto the LORD which were proclaimed in their **Seasons**.

Seasons: (H4150) - feasts, solemn assembly, holy convocations, time, appointed times.

The Biblical Calendar **Christ's Crucifixion Timeline** According to the 4 Gospels, Christ: Abib 14 - Passover Died Rested Abib 15 - Unleav. Bread Resurrected Abib 16 - Firstfruits Sent the 3<sup>rd</sup> Month 9 - Pentecost Holy Spirit (Acts 2:1-13).

## The Biblical Calendar Calculation of the New Moon Phases

"...The Jewish Feast period began with the month of barley harvest; and its paschal moon, or moon of [**Abib**], was the **appointed moon** of **barley** harvest....

## The Biblical Calendar Facts Connected with the Crucifixion

**Based on the Luni-Solar Barley Harvest Calendar: Fact 5.** Christ died at: the Feast of Passover **Fact 6.** Christ rested on: the Feast of Unleavened Bread and a 7<sup>th</sup> day Sabbath **Fact 7.** Christ resurrected at: Firstfruits Fact 8. ## The Biblical Calendar **The Creation Sabbath**

"When there shall be a "restitution of all things, which God has spoken by the mouth of all his holy prophets since the world began" (Acts 3:21), the creation Sabbath, the day on which Jesus lay at rest in Joseph's tomb, will still be a day of rest and rejoicing."

## The Biblical Calendar Creation Sabbath: the 7<sup>th</sup> Day Sabbath Conclusion:

1. Christ **rested** on the Creation Sabbath, **Abib 15<sup>th</sup>**, the **7<sup>th</sup> day Sabbath**.

**2.** Christ **resurrected** the first day of the week, Abib 16<sup>th</sup>.

**3.** Christ **fulfilled** the Luni-Solar **Barley** Harvest Mosaic Law Calendar.

**4.** Christ fulfilled the **Calendar**, Biblically, Astronomically, Chronologically and Historically.

#### The Biblical Calendar Christ rested on the Creation Sabbath
