Upkeep of the Health Center – Nursing Aid and Caregivers:

- Assign a cleaning team every week to care for the Health Center
- Clean the Health center every day
- Make sure there is no dust under the beds
- Make sure all mattress protectors, sheets, pillow cases are clean
- Clean all garbage pails
- Nursing Aides – Caregivers are responsible for the laundry, washing, drying, folding towels and sheets each time there are patients-clients
- Always change mattress protector, bed sheet, covering sheet, pillow case for each new patient-client
- Wear mask if necessary – always wear medical gloves when attending patients-clients and change them for each patient-client

How to address a patient-client
 - Teach nursing aide – caregiver how to address the patient-client by name
First name for a child – Mr. Mrs. last name for adults unless the patient-client is known
 - Nursing Aides – Caregivers should be reminded to pray with their patients-clients for their health concerns – family and whatever the client has share with them of their needs – this should be kept confidential as we need to protect the privacy of each patient-client
 - However, the registration form, letter to exonerate and health evaluation must be given to teacher/instructor for each patient-client in order to have these important information on file.

Explain how to fill up Forms for a patient-client – Brother Amos

- **Registration Form:**
Prepare registration form for each client – name – address – phone number – ailment
- **Letter to Exonerate:**
Have a Letter to Exonerate signed by patient-client – keep in file
- **Health Evaluation – 8 Laws of Health**
Make sure to have the 8 Laws of Health sheet and give it to patient-client to answer questions and for them to bring home – the Health Evaluation stays for the Health Center files
