The Message of the Trumpet

1. How Should the Trumpet be Sounded?

“Blow ye the trumpet in Zion, and sound an alarm in my holy mountain.”
Joel 2:1.

“For if the trumpet give an uncertain sound, who shall prepare himself to the battle?” 1 Corinthians 14:8.

1. “If ye go to *war* in your land against the enemy that oppresseth you, then ye shall blow an alarm with the trumpets.” Numbers 10:9.
2. We are at war – “For we wrestle not against flesh and blood, but against principalities, against powers, against the rulers of the darkness of this world, against spiritual wickedness in high places.” Ephesians 6:12.
3. Let us – “Put on the whole armour of God, that *we* may be able to stand against the wiles of the devil.” Ephesians 6:11.
4. Physical and Spiritual War – “The dragon was wroth with the woman, and went to make *war* with the remnant of her seed, which keep the commandments of God, and have the testimony of Jesus Christ.” Revelation 12:17, Italics added.

2. What Sound Must the Trumpet Give?

“For if the trumpet give an uncertain sound, who shall prepare himself to the battle?” 1 Corinthians 14:8.

“Blow ye the trumpet in Zion, and sound an alarm in my holy mountain.”
Joel 2:1.

1. The Trumpet must give a certain, distinct and definite sound so the people will be prepared for the battle. It must give a “*life giving sound* [eternal life sound], a distinction in the *sounds*,” otherwise how shall it be known why and what is the trumpet sounding for? 1 Corinthians 14:7, 8.
2. And What is the Trumpet Sound? “I was in the Spirit on the Lord's day, and heard behind me a great *voice*, as of a *trumpet*....And I turned to see the *voice* that spake with me. And being turned, I saw seven golden candlesticks And in the midst of the seven candlesticks one like unto the *Son of man*” Revelation 1:10, 12. – The Trumpet is a *VOICE*, Italics added.

3. How Does the Trumpet as a Voice Speak?

“Blow ye the trumpet in Zion, and sound an alarm in my holy mountain: let all the inhabitants of the land tremble for the day of the LORD cometh, for it is nigh at hand.” Joel 2:1.

1. The Voice as of a Trumpet speaks “By revelation, or by knowledge, or by prophesying, or by doctrine.” 1 Corinthians 14:6.
2. If we do not give this kind of sound or speak in this manner, the people will not be prepared for the battle and the war ahead: “So likewise ye, except ye utter by the tongue *words easy to be understood*, how shall it be known what is spoken? for ye shall speak into the air.” 1 Corinthians 14:9.
3. The alarm trumpet warns us of the Last *Trumpet* which is soon to blow: “In a moment, in the twinkling of an eye, at the last trump: for the *trumpet shall sound*, and the dead shall be raised incorruptible, and we shall be changed.” 1 Corinthians 15:52, Italics added.

4. What Message is the Voice giving?



“So shall my word be that goeth forth out of my mouth: it shall not return unto me void, but it shall accomplish that which I please, and it shall prosper in the thing whereto I sent it.” Isaiah 55:11.

1. A Unique and Clear Message – “There are, it may be, so many kinds of voices in the world, and none of them is without signification. Therefore if I know not the meaning of the *voice*, I shall be unto him that speaketh a barbarian, and he that speaketh shall be a barbarian unto me.” 1 Corinthians 14:10, 11.
2. “This is the beginning of the light of the angel whose glory shall fill the whole earth. For it is the work of every one to whom the *message of warning* has come, to lift up Jesus, to present Him to the world as revealed in types, as shadowed in symbols, as manifested in the revelations of the prophets, as unveiled in the lessons given to His disciples and in the wonderful miracles wrought for the sons of men. Search the Scriptures; for they are they that testify of Him.”

5. Whose Voice as of a Trumpet Sounds the Alarm?

“Again the word of the LORD came unto me, saying, Son of man, speak to the children of thy people, and say unto them, When I bring the sword upon a land, if the people of the land take a man of their coasts, and set him for their *watchman*: If when he seeth the sword come upon the land, he *blow the trumpet*, and *warn* the people; Then whosoever heareth the *sound of the trumpet*, and taketh not warning; if the sword come, and take him away, his blood shall be upon his own head.

He heard the *sound of the trumpet*, and took not warning; his blood shall be upon him. But he that taketh warning shall deliver his soul. But if the *watchman* see the sword come, and *blow not the trumpet*, and the people be not warned; if the sword come, and take any person from among them, he is taken away in his iniquity; but his blood will I require at the *watchman's hand*. So thou, O son of man, I have set thee a *watchman* unto the house of Israel; therefore thou shalt hear the word at my mouth, and *warn them from me*.” Ezekiel 33:1-7, Italics added.

6. Who is Giving the Message of the Trumpet?

“I counsel thee to buy of me gold tried in the fire, that thou mayest be rich; and white raiment, that thou mayest be clothed, and that the shame of thy nakedness do not appear; and anoint thine eyes with eyesalve, that thou mayest see.

As many as I love, I rebuke and chasten: be zealous therefore, and repent. Behold, I stand at the door, and knock: if any man hear my *voice*, and open the door, I will come in to him, and will sup with him, and he with me”
Revelation 3:18-20 – Message to the 7th Church – Italics added.
