The Message of the Trumpet

1. Whose Voice as of a Trumpet Sounds the Alarm?

“Again the word of the LORD came unto me, saying, Son of man, speak to the children of thy people, and say unto them, When I bring the sword upon a land, if the people of the land take a man of their coasts, and set him for their *watchman*: If when he seeth the sword come upon the land, he *blow the trumpet*, and *warn* the people; Then whosoever heareth the *sound of the trumpet*, and taketh not warning; if the sword come, and take him away, his blood shall be upon his own head.

He heard the *sound of the trumpet*, and took not warning; his blood shall be upon him. But he that taketh warning shall deliver his soul. But if the *watchman* see the sword come, and *blow not the trumpet*, and the people be not warned; if the sword come, and take any person from among them, he is taken away in his iniquity; but his blood will I require at the *watchman's hand*. So thou, O son of man, I have set thee a *watchman* unto the house of Israel; therefore thou shalt hear the word at my mouth, and *warn them from me*.” Ezekiel 33:1-7, Italics added.

2. Who Is the Watchman on the Walls of Zion?

“The people of the land [should] take a *man of their coasts* [*margin: one of their own*], and set him for their watchman.” Ezekiel 33:2, Italics Added.

“He [Aaron] shall send him [the goat] away by the hand of a *fit man* [*margin: a man of the congregation*], into the wilderness:” Leviticus 16:21.

“A Lamb stood on the mount Zion, and with him *an hundred forty and four thousand*, having his Father's name written in their foreheads.” Revelation 14:1.

1. “Then, while the plagues are falling, the Scape Goat [Satan] is being led away. He makes a mighty struggle to escape, but *he is held fast by the hand that leads him.*” Spaulding and Magan's collection, p. 2. Italics added.
2. “Upon the crystal sea before the throne...are gathered the company that have "gotten the victory over the *beast, and over his image, and over his mark, and over the number of his name.*" Revelation 15:2. With the Lamb upon Mount Zion, "having the harps of God," they stand, *the hundred and forty and four thousand* that were redeemed from among men.” Revelation 14:3, Italics Added

3. What is the Message of the Voice as of a Trumpet?

“Blow ye the trumpet in Zion, and sound an alarm in my holy mountain.
Joel 2:1.

“I was in the Spirit on the Lord's day, and heard behind me *a great voice, as of a trumpet*.... And I turned to see the voice that spake with me....one like unto the Son of man.” Revelation 1:10, 12.

1. The Voice as of a Trumpet speaks: “By revelation, by knowledge, by prophecy, by doctrine.” 1 Corinthians 14:6.
2. The Message is based on the Three Angels Messages of Revelation 14:6-12, and an another angel and a voice from heaven in Revelation 18:1-4:
 - “Saying with a *loud voice [as of a trumpet]*, *Fear God*...” Revelation 14:7.
 - “And there followed another angel saying, *Babylon is fallen*....” V. 8.
 - “And the third angel followed them, saying with a *loud voice*....” V. 9.
 - “Another angel...having great power, and the earth was lightened with His glory; cried mightily with a *strong voice*, *Babylon is fallen*....” Revelation 18:1-4.

4. Who Gives the Message of the Trumpet?

"With the Lamb upon Mount Zion, "having the harps of God," they stand, the hundred and forty and four thousand that were redeemed from among men. These are they which came out of great tribulation; ...they have passed through the time of trouble such as never was since there was a nation [Daniel 12:1]; they have endured the anguish of the time of Jacob's trouble; they have stood without an intercessor through the final outpouring of God's judgments.

But they have been delivered, for they have "washed their robes, and made them white in the blood of the Lamb." "In their mouth was found no guile; for they are without fault" before God. "Therefore are they before the throne of God, and serve him day and night in his temple; and he that sitteth on the throne shall dwell among them." Revelation 14:1-5; 15:3; 7:14-17."

4. Who Gives the Message of the Trumpet?

“They have seen the earth wasted with famine and pestilence, the sun having power to scorch men with great heat, and they themselves have endured suffering, hunger, and thirst. But “they shall hunger no more; neither thirst any more; neither shall the sun light on them, nor any heat; for the Lamb which is in the midst of the throne shall feed them, and shall lead them unto living fountains of waters; and God shall wipe away all tears from their eyes.” Revelation 14:1-5; 15:3; 7:14-17.” The Great Controversy, 648,649.

“Soon we heard the voice of God like many waters, which gave us the day and hour of Jesus' coming. The living saints, *144,000 in number*, knew and understood the voice, while the wicked thought it was thunder and an earthquake. When God spoke the time, He poured upon us the Holy Ghost, and our faces began to light up and shine with the glory of God, as Moses' did when he came down from Mount Sinai.” Early Writings, 15, Italics Added.

5. How to Prepare to be the Voice as of a Trumpet?

“Let us strive with all the power that God has given us to be among the hundred and forty-four thousand. And let us do all that we can to help others to gain heaven. We are to have an intense interest in Christ Jesus; for he is our Saviour. He came to this world to be tempted in all points as we are, to prove to the universe that in this world of sin human beings can live lives that God will approve.” Review & Herald, March 9, 1905.
