1. What is the Definition of a Remnant?

“Ye children of Israel, turn again unto the LORD God of Abraham, Isaac, and Israel, and he will return to the *remnant* of you.” 2 Chronicles 30:6.

- *Definition of a Remnant*

An usually small part, member, or trace remaining

A small surviving group – often used in plural

An unsold or unused end of piece goods

- Old Testament – New Testament

“Notwithstanding Israel’s failure as a nation, there remained among them a *goodly remnant* of such as should be saved. At the time of the Saviour’s advent there were *faithful men and women* who had *received with gladness* the message of John the Baptist, and had thus been led to study anew the prophecies concerning the Messiah. When the early Christian church was founded, it was composed of these *faithful Jews* who recognized Jesus of Nazareth as the one for whose advent they had been longing.” The Acts of the Apostles, 376, Italics Added.

2. Did God Preserve a Remnant of Old Israel?



“The *remnant* shall return, even the remnant of Jacob, unto the mighty God.”
Isaiah 10:21.

“Even so then at this present time also there is a *remnant* according to the election of grace.” Romans 11:5.

“Even though Israel rejected His Son, God did not reject them. Listen to Paul as he continues the argument in Romans 11:1 - 4: “I say then, Hath God cast away His people? God forbid. For I also am an Israelite, of the *seed of Abraham*, of the tribe of Benjamin. God hath not cast away His people which He foreknew. Wot ye not what the Scripture saith of Elias? how he maketh intercession to God against Israel, saying, Lord, they have killed Thy prophets, and digged down Thine altars; and I am left alone, and they seek my life.

But what saith the answer of God unto him? I have reserved to Myself seven thousand men, who have not bowed the knee to the image of Baal. Even so then at this present time also there is a *remnant* according to the election of grace.”

3. What is the Remnant Compared to by Paul?

“Who is a God like unto thee, that pardoneth iniquity, and passeth by the transgression of the *remnant* of his heritage? He retaineth not his anger for ever, because he delighteth in mercy.” Micah 7:18.

“Paul refers to the remnant when he writes, “If the first fruit be holy, the lump is also holy: and if the root be holy, so are the branches.”

Paul likens the *remnant* in Israel to a *noble olive tree*, some of whose branches have been broken off. He compares the *Gentiles* to branches from a *wild olive tree, grafted into the parent stock*. “If some of the branches be broken off,” he writes to the Gentile believers, “and thou, being a wild olive tree, wert grafted in among them, and with them partakest of the root and fatness of the olive tree; boast not against the branches.

But if thou boast, thou bearest not the root, but the root thee. Thou wilt say then, The branches were broken off, that I might be grafted in. Well; *because of unbelief they were broken off*, and thou standest by faith.” Romans 11:16-21.

4. Remnant of Israel and Israel of God Saved

“Be not high-minded, but fear: for if God spared not the natural branches, take heed lest He also spare not thee. Behold therefore the goodness and severity of God: on them which fell, severity; but toward thee, goodness, if thou continue in His goodness: otherwise thou also shalt be cut off.” Romans 11:20-22.

Through unbelief and the rejection of Heaven’s purpose for her, Israel as a nation had lost her connection with God. But the branches that had been separated from the parent stock God was able to reunite with the true stock of Israel—the *remnant* who had remained true to the God of their fathers. “They also,” the apostle declares of these broken branches, “if they abide not still in unbelief, shall be grafted in: for God is able to graft them in again.” Romans 11:23.

....Thus Paul shows that God is abundantly able to transform the hearts of Jew and Gentile alike, and to grant to every believer in Christ the blessings promised to Israel. He repeats Isaiah’s declaration concerning God’s people: “Though the number of the children of Israel be as the sand of the sea, a *remnant* shall be saved.” Romans 9:27. The Acts of the Apostles, 377 – 378, Italics Added.

5. What is the Timeline of Israel's Remnant?

“They shall sanctify My name, and sanctify the Holy One of Jacob, and shall fear the God of Israel. They also that erred in spirit shall come to understanding, and they that murmured shall learn doctrine.” Isaiah 29:22-24.

“In the closing proclamation of the gospel, when special work is to be done for classes of people hitherto neglected, *God expects His messengers to take particular interest in the Jewish people* whom they find in all parts of the earth. As *the Old Testament Scriptures are blended with the New in an explanation of Jehovah's eternal purpose*, this will be to many of the Jews as the *dawn of a new creation, the resurrection of the soul*. As they see *the Christ of the gospel dispensation* portrayed in the pages of the Old Testament Scriptures, and perceive how clearly the New Testament explains the Old, their slumbering faculties will be aroused, and they will recognize Christ as the Saviour of the world. Many will by faith receive Christ as their Redeemer. To them will be fulfilled the words, “As many as received Him, to them gave He power to become the *sons of God*, even to them that believe on His name.” John 1:12.” The Acts of the Apostles, 381, Italics Added.

6. Identifying the Woman in Revelation 12:1 – 4



- “And there appeared a great wonder in heaven; a woman clothed with the *sun*, and the *moon* under her feet, and upon her head a crown of *twelve stars*.”
Revelation 12:1.

- “And she being with *child* cried, travailing in birth, and pained to be delivered.”
Revelation 12:2.

- “And there appeared another wonder in heaven; and behold a great *red dragon*, having seven heads and ten horns, and seven crowns upon his heads.”
Revelation 12:3.

- “And his tail drew the third part of the stars of heaven, and did cast them to the earth: and the *dragon stood before the woman* which was ready to be delivered, for to *devour her child* as soon as it was born.”
Revelation 12:4.

7. Identifying the Woman in Revelation 12:1, 2, 4



- “And there appeared a great wonder in heaven; a woman clothed with the *sun*, and the *moon* under her feet, and upon her head a crown of *twelve stars*.” Revelation 12:1.
- “A *Woman* [is] a figure which is used in the Bible as the symbol of a church, a virtuous woman representing a pure church, a vile woman an apostate church.” *The Great Controversy*, 380.
- The Woman of Revelation 12:1 is the Woman – *Church of the Creation Calendar Reckoning of the True Sabbath and Solemn Assemblies of Leviticus 23*.
- The Woman giving birth in Revelation 12:2, 4 is the Mother Mary and her Child Jesus. It also relates to the symbol of a Church identified in Acts 11:26: “And the disciples were called *Christians* first in Antioch.”
- The Dragon who wants to destroy both the Mother and the Child is “The great dragon [who] was cast out, that old serpent, called the Devil, and Satan, which deceiveth the whole world.” Revelation 12:9.

8. Identifying the Woman in Revelation 12:5

- “And she [the woman] brought forth a man child, who was to rule all nations with a rod of iron: and her child *was caught up* unto God, and to his throne.” Revelation 12:5.
- The Child of the Woman who was caught unto God is Christ at His ascension in heaven: “And when he had spoken these things, while they beheld, he was taken up; and a cloud received him out of their sight.
-And while they looked steadfastly toward heaven as he went up, behold, two men stood by them in white apparel; which also said, Ye men of Galilee, why stand ye gazing up into heaven? this same Jesus, which is taken up from you into heaven, shall so come in like manner as ye have seen him go into heaven.” Acts 1:9 – 11.

9. Identifying the Woman in Revelation 12:6



- “And the woman fled into the wilderness, where she hath a place prepared of God, that they should feed her there a thousand two hundred and threescore days.” Revelation 12:6.

“In the sixth century [538 AD] the papacy had become firmly established. Its seat of power was fixed in the imperial city, and the bishop of Rome was declared to be the head over the entire church. Paganism had given place to the papacy. The dragon had given to the beast “his power, and his seat, and great authority.” Revelation 13:2. *And now began the 1260 years [538 -1798] of papal oppression foretold in the prophecies of Daniel [7:25] and the Revelation [13:5-7].*

Christians were forced to choose, either to yield their integrity and accept the papal ceremonies and worship, or to wear away their lives in dungeons or suffer death by the rack, the fagot, or the headsman’s ax. Now were fulfilled the words of Jesus, “Ye shall be betrayed both by parents, and brethren, and kinsfolks, and friends; and some of you shall they cause to be put to death. And ye shall be hated of all men for my name’s sake.” [Luke 21:16, 17.]”

10. Identifying the Woman in Revelation 12:6



- “And the woman fled into the wilderness, where she hath a place prepared of God, that they should feed her there *a thousand two hundred and threescore days.*” Revelation 12:6, Italics Added.

“Persecution opened upon the faithful with greater fury than ever before, and the world became a vast battle-field. For hundreds of years the church of Christ found refuge in seclusion and obscurity. Thus says the prophet: “The woman *fled into the wilderness*, where she hath a place prepared of God, that they should feed her there *a thousand two hundred and threescore days.*” [1260 Days of Years – Revelation 12:6].”

The accession of the Roman Church to power marked the beginning of the Dark Ages. As her power increased, the darkness deepened. Faith was transferred from Christ, the true foundation, to the pope of Rome. Instead of trusting in the Son of God for forgiveness of sins and for eternal salvation, the people looked to the pope, and to the priests and prelates to whom he delegated authority.” The Great Controversy, 54, Italics Added.

11. Identifying the Woman in Revelation 12:14

- “And when the dragon saw that he was cast unto the earth, he persecuted the woman which brought forth the man child.”

Revelation 12:13.

- “And to the woman were given two wings of a great eagle, that she might fly into the wilderness, into her place, where she is nourished for a time, and times, and half a time, from the face of the serpent.”

- Revelation 12:14 – Daniel 12:7, 11, 12 – 1260 – 1290 – 1335 Literal Days – USL

- “And to the woman were given *two wings of a great eagle*, [Emblem of the USA] that she might fly into the wilderness, into her place, where she is nourished for a time, and times, and half a time, from the face of the serpent.” Revelation 12:14, Italics Added.

- “When our nation [USA] shall so abjure the principles of its government as to enact a *Sunday law*, Protestantism will in this act join hands with popery; it will be nothing else than giving life to the tyranny which has long been eagerly watching its opportunity to spring again into active despotism.”

12. Identifying the Woman in Revelation 12:14



- “But what has been the course of God’s servants in ages past? When the disciples preached Christ and Him crucified, after His resurrection, the authorities commanded them not to speak any more nor to teach in the name of Jesus [Acts 4:19]: “But Peter and John answered and said unto them, *Whether it be right in the sight of God to hearken unto you more than unto God, judge ye. For we cannot but speak the things which we have seen and heard.*” Testimonies to the Church, Volume 5, 713, Italics Added,
- “By the decree of enforcing the institution of the Papacy in violation of the law of God, our nation [USA] will disconnect herself fully from righteousness. When Protestantism shall stretch her hand across the gulf to grasp the hand of the Roman power, when she shall reach over the abyss to *clasp hands with Spiritualism*, when, under the influence of this threefold union, our country *shall repudiate every principle of its Constitution as a Protestant and Republican government*, and shall make provision for the propagation of papal falsehoods and delusions, then we may know *that the time has come for the marvelous working of Satan, and that the end is near.*” Testimonies to the Church, Volume 5, 451, Italics Added.

14. The Mystery of the “Seed” Revealed



- “And the dragon was wroth with the *woman*, and went to make war with the *remnant of her seed*, which keep the commandments of God, and have the testimony of Jesus Christ.” Revelation 12:17, Italics Added.
- “And God said unto *Abraham*, Thou shalt *keep my covenant* therefore, thou, and *thy seed* after thee in their generations.” Genesis 17:9, Italics Added.

15. The Remnant and Her Seed Timeline

- “And it shall come to pass afterward, that I will pour out My Spirit upon all flesh; and your sons and your daughters shall *prophesy*, your old men shall dream dreams, your young men shall see visions; and also upon the servants and upon the handmaids in those days will I pour out My Spirit. And I will show wonders in the heavens and in the earth, blood, and fire, and pillars of smoke.
- The sun shall be turned into darkness, and the moon into blood, before the great and the terrible day of the Lord come. And it shall come to pass, that *whosoever shall call on the name of the Lord shall be delivered*: For in Mount Zion and in Jerusalem shall be deliverance, as the Lord hath said, and in the *remnant* whom the Lord shall call.” Joel 2:28-32, Italics Added.

16. The Remnant and Her Seed Timeline

- “This prophecy of Joel 2:28-32, which speaks of the outpouring of the Holy Spirit in the last days, *was not all fulfilled at the beginning of the gospel dispensation*. This is evident from the wonders in heaven and in earth, introduced in this text, which were to be precursors of “The great and terrible day of the Lord.” Though we have had the signs, that terrible day is still in the future.
- The whole gospel dispensation may be called the last days, but to say that the last days are all [2000] years in the past, is *incorrect*. *They reach to the day of the Lord and to the deliverance of the remnant of God’s people*: “For in Mount Zion and in Jerusalem shall be deliverance, as the Lord hath said, and in the *remnant* whom the Lord shall call.”

17. Remnant of Her Seed – Last Generation

- “This remnant, *existing amid the signs and wonders that usher in the great and terrible day of the Lord*, is doubtless the *remnant of the seed of the woman* spoken of in Revelation 12:17—*the last generation of the church on earth*. “And the dragon was wroth with the woman, and went to make war with *the remnant of her seed, which keep the commandments of God, and have the testimony of Jesus Christ.*”
- The remnant of the *gospel church will have the gifts*. War will be waged against them *because they keep the commandments of God and have the testimony of Jesus Christ*. Revelation 12:17. In Revelation 19:10, the testimony of Jesus is defined to be the *spirit of prophecy*. Said the angel, “I am thy fellow servant, and of thy brethren that have *the testimony of Jesus.*” In Revelation 22:9, he repeats the same in substance, as follows: “I am thy fellow servant, and of thy brethren the prophets.” From the comparison we see the force of the expression, “*The testimony of Jesus is the spirit of prophecy.*” Early Writings, 143, Italics Added.

18. Remnant of Her Seed – Holy Spirit's Gifts

- “The *testimony of Jesus includes all the gifts of that one Spirit*. Says Paul: “I thank my God always on your behalf, for the grace of God which is given you by Jesus Christ; that in everything ye are enriched by Him, in all utterance, and in all knowledge; even as the *Testimony of Christ [Spirit of Prophecy]* was confirmed in you: *So that ye come behind in no gift*; waiting for the coming of our Lord Jesus Christ.” 1 Corinthians 1:4-7.
- The testimony of Christ was confirmed in the Corinthian church; and what was the result? *They came behind in no gift*. Are we not justified, then, in the conclusion that when *the remnant are fully confirmed in the testimony of Jesus*, they will come behind in no gift, waiting for the coming of our Lord Jesus Christ?” Early Writings, 143, Italics Added.
- “Now concerning spiritual gifts, brethren, I would not have you ignorant: for to one is given by the Spirit the word of wisdom, ...to one knowledge, ...to one faith, ...to one healing, ...to one miracles, ...to one prophecy, ...to one discerning of spirits, ...to one divers kinds of tongues, ...to one interpretation of tongues, ...to one help, ...to one government.”. 1 Corinthians 12:8-10, 28.

19. Wise Virgins – 144000 – Remnant of Her Seed

- “And the dragon was wroth with the woman, and went to make war with the *remnant of her seed*, which keep the commandments of God, and have the *testimony of Jesus Christ*.” Revelation 12:17, Italics Added.
- “For the testimony of Jesus is the spirit of prophecy.” Revelation 19:10, Italics Added.
- The *Wise Virgins*, the *144000*, the *Remnant of her Seed* are *One*
- Existing amid the signs and wonders that usher in the *great and terrible day of the Lord* and is doubtless the *Last Generation of the Church on Earth*.
